

## Baccalaureate School for Global Education (BSGE) 2008-2009 Application Procedures for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Applicants

- Primary point of entry is grade 7.
- Applicants to BSGE must be residents of Queens.

**The BSGE screening process occurs in two parts:**  
(Please refer to the chart below for additional information.)

**Part I: Testing and Application** (Sign up for the January 10<sup>th</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup> test date by email or in person)  
*Please note that additional documents will not be considered. BSGE cannot make photocopies of applicant documents.*

**On the day of the test, students must bring the following items with them to be admitted to the test:**

1. A testing ticket
2. Fully completed BSGE application form that includes:
  - Guidance counselor recommendation
  - Teacher Recommendation
  - A copy of the first quarter 6<sup>th</sup> grade report card
  - A copy of the final 5<sup>th</sup> grade report card

**Part II: Applicant Interviews** (Eligible students to be interviewed will be contacted by March 6<sup>th</sup>)  
*Families will receive a letter by March 6<sup>th</sup> notifying them if their child will have an interview. Please note that an invitation to an interview is not an offer of admissions. Applicants will be interviewed by BSGE faculty in small groups.*

**On the day of the interview, students do not need to bring any additional materials.**
